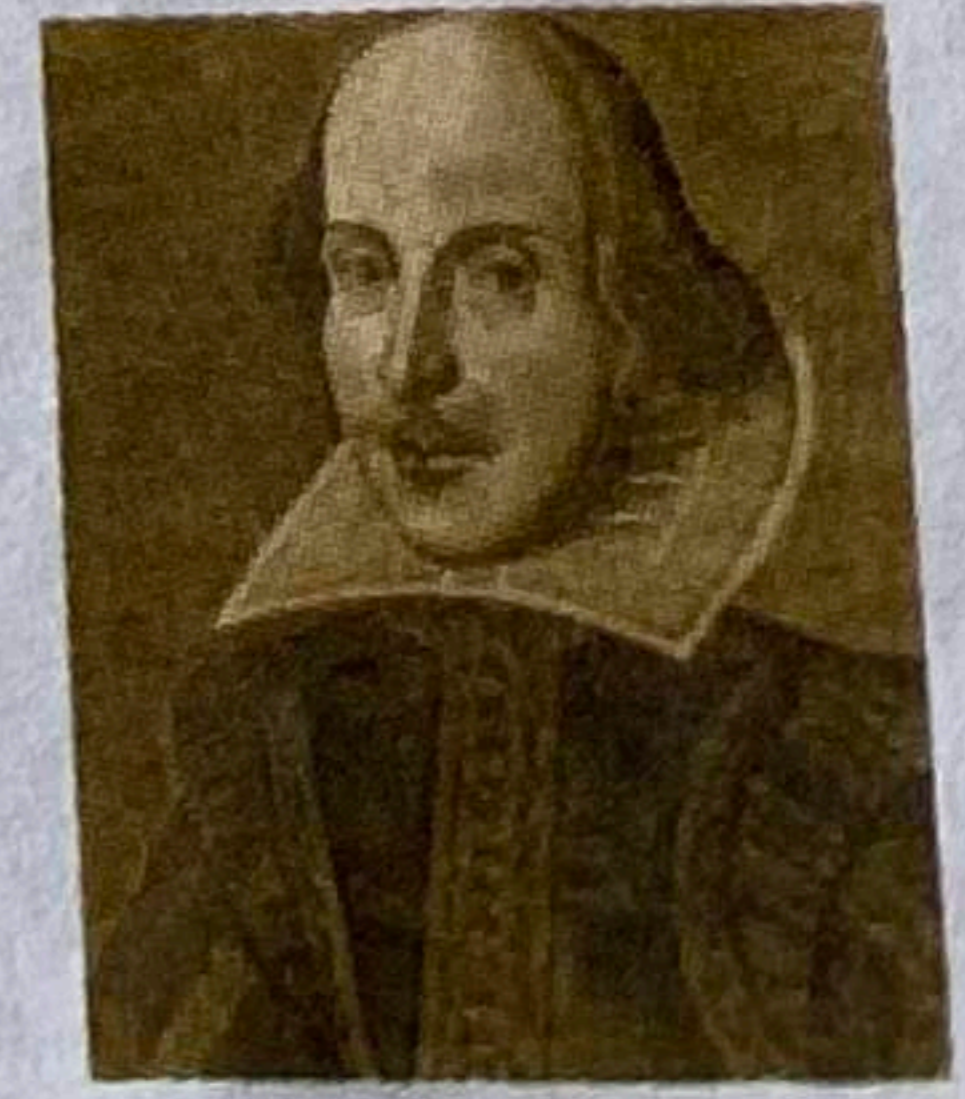




Exercise 3. Write *As* for assertive, *In* for interrogative, *Im* for imperative and *Ex* for exclamatory sentences:
